## China portable power station in Myanmar

Who owns Sino-Myanmar power station?

The Sino-Myanmar power station is owned by the Yunnan company, which holds 80pc of the joint-venture. The company will be fully in charge of the project construction, operation, and management for 40 years after its completion, and then transfer it to the Myanmar government.

How much electricity does Myanmar get from power stations?

Under all the joint-venture agreements, Myanmar is entitled to get 10 to 15 percent of the annual electricity generation from the power stations free of charge.

Is MEPE building a power station in Myanmar?

MEPE is expected to begin work soon on building a 33-MW power station in Myanmar. The project will have one gas-powered turbine and another that uses steam. Most of the project funding is to be provided by the Japanese government.

Where is powerchina located?

Located in Magway Province, Myanmar and with a total installed capacity of 40.28 MWp, the power station is projected to generate 64.64 million kWh of electricity for the grid on average per year. Since the start of the project, POWERCHINA has completed various tasks, such as power agreement signing and land leases.
