How are solar panels taxed?

Other system components such as inverters and batteries were taxed at 18%. 2018 - 21st Sep 2025: Solar power generating systems are taxed under a "composite supply rule," where 70% of the system cost is taxed at 12% GST (for panels), while 30% is taxed at 12% GST (for inverters and other parts).
